

Utility Right of Way Construction



Protect yourselves and your property against underground utility damage and liability. Find out where the underground utility lines might be buried before you dig. The service is free AND IT'S THE LAW.

Penalties for cutting utility lines can be severe. Learn more at www.digsafelyoregon.com. Just about anywhere you dig, there could be services buried underground - water, sewer, electricity, natural gas. Homeowners and contractors can prevent damage to underground utilities and prevent service interruptions by calling the Oregon Utility Notification Center at least two working days prior to excavating. The various utility companies will be notified to mark out the location of their lines within two working days of notification.
