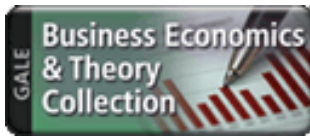


## Professional Development

**Computer Database:** Use this collection to find computer-related product introductions, news articles, software, electronics, engineering, communications and the application of technology.



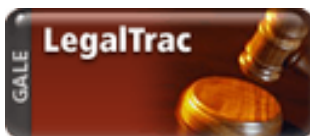
