Welcome to the Independence bicycle and boater campground. We are excited you have chosen to stay with us and want to make sure we provide you with all of the tools to make your experience great! In this brochure you will find a list of local eateries and grocery stores as well as other fun things to do in the area but first, lets get through the boring yet important stuff: The Rules of the Campground.

Campground Rules

- >>>> Camping is only allowed within the designated camping area at the North end of Riverview Park
- Camping is limited to bicycles & boaters. No motorized vehicles allowed for camping or parking overnight
- >>> Campground is first come first serve. No reservations allowed
- >>>→ Max occupancy of 8 people per night
- Riverview Park is smoke free. Smoking is only allowed in designated smoking areas
- No alcohol allowed in the campground
- \longrightarrow Campers can stay a max of two nights. This may be extended by City Hall in special circumstances
- Camping Fee \$10 per site per night. Please see camp host or pay at pay station
- >>> Campers are responsible for securing their own belongings
- Camp quiet hours are from 10pm to 7am
- → Non-registered visitors must exit the park by ⋙-10pm

Campground Rules (cont'd)

- Campground is closed during the July 4th weekend and for other community events. Check with City Hall.
- Campers are responsible for clearing their area of all litter before exiting the campsite. Failure to do so may result in a citation being issued for Offensive Litter
- Any violation of park policies, City Ordinances or State Laws may also result in a camper being trespassed from the campground and asked to leave the park without a refund
- \longrightarrow If you observe a violation to any of these policies or law violations please report them to (503) 838-1214 or call 911 for an emergency
