Today we celebrate Veteran's Day, a time in which we honor and recognize the service these men and women gave to our country.



Through Billy's stories and those of his fellow veterans, we begin to understand the sacrifices made on our country's behalf.



#### Fall Leaf Pick Up Program Continues

It's that time of the year when leaves are all over the place, and backyards start piling up. That's why our Independence Public Works Department puts on a Leaf Pickup Program every year, where they cruise through the city and help keep our streets and spaces clean.

Here are a few important things to remember during this season:

- Leaves only, no other yard debris
- Remove leaves blocking storm drains.

- Small leaf piles need to go in your yard debris can.
- Cars need to be parked at least five feet from leaf piles.
- Leave a minimum of one foot between the curb and leaf pile and no piles in the corners of cul-de-sacs or in front of mailboxes.
- Property owners are responsible for the disposal of leaves after the week of December 26th.

November 14th

November 28th

December 12th

December 26th
