



# CITY OF INDEPENDENCE PARADE OR ROAD CLOSURE PERMIT APPLICATION

**Independence Municipal Code 26-256 Permit Required:**

*No person shall organize or participate in a parade which may disrupt or interfere with traffic without obtaining a permit. A permit shall always be required of a procession of people utilizing the public right-of-way and consisting of 15 or more persons or five or more vehicles.*

Please complete the following application and turn it into the Chief of Police at least 15 days prior to the intended date of the parade or road closure. If the parade is on a state highway, a separate parade permit may be required by the state.
