

Heritage Museum Offers Exhibit on Oregon's Statehood



Like its people, Oregon's landscape is diverse. It was built from many parts, each adding its own character to the state. Oregon grows and matures as islands and pieces of continents come crashing in, the Cascades erupt, lava covers the landscape, desert mountains grow, and huge floods sculpt the scenery. Oregon is indeed a masterpiece of geologic artistry! In 2009, Oregon celebrated 150 years as a state, but Oregon's landscape has a much longer history. Geological processes have been building the state's landscape for more than 150 million years!

The windows in the traveling exhibit from the Oregon Historical Society illustrate how geology crafted Oregon's landscape and natural resources and continues to shape the land and lives of its citizens. The most iconic of Oregon's landscapes; Crater Lake, Multnomah Falls, Newberry Crater, Steens Mountain, the Painted Hills, and so much more, display Oregon's geologic splendor.

Developed by and on loan to the Heritage Museum from the Oregon Historical Society, this exhibit was created in collaboration with the Oregon State University Department of Geosciences, Oregon Department of Geology and Mineral Industries, Oregon Paleo Lands Institute, OSU Hatfield Marine Science Center, Portland State University, and the Oregon Department of Energy.
