In November 2023, Independence city council approved amending the city utility fee schedule, specifically the section that requires deposits for those connecting to the city's water system. This was done to increase accessibility and affordability to those seeking to establish a residency here in the city.

Therefore, if your utility account is in good standing, your deposit and interest have been applied to all accounts. The city no longer requires deposits for water/sewer service.
